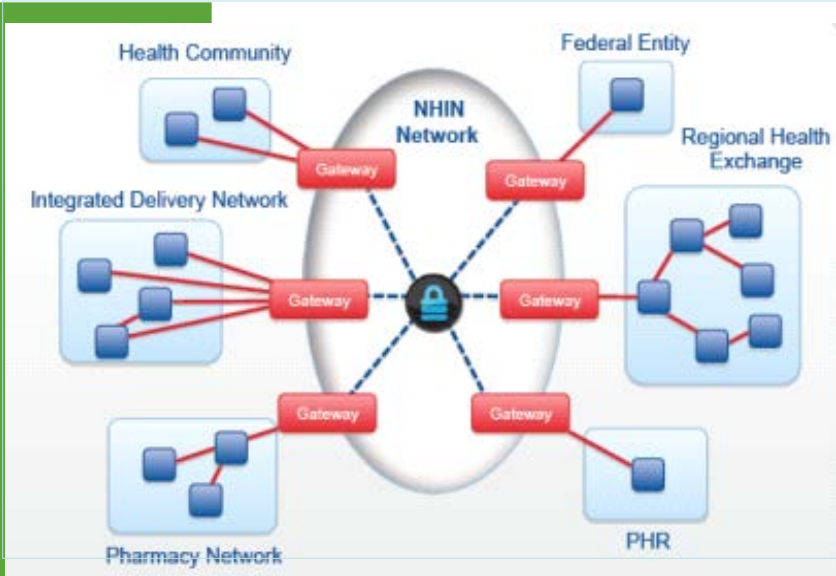
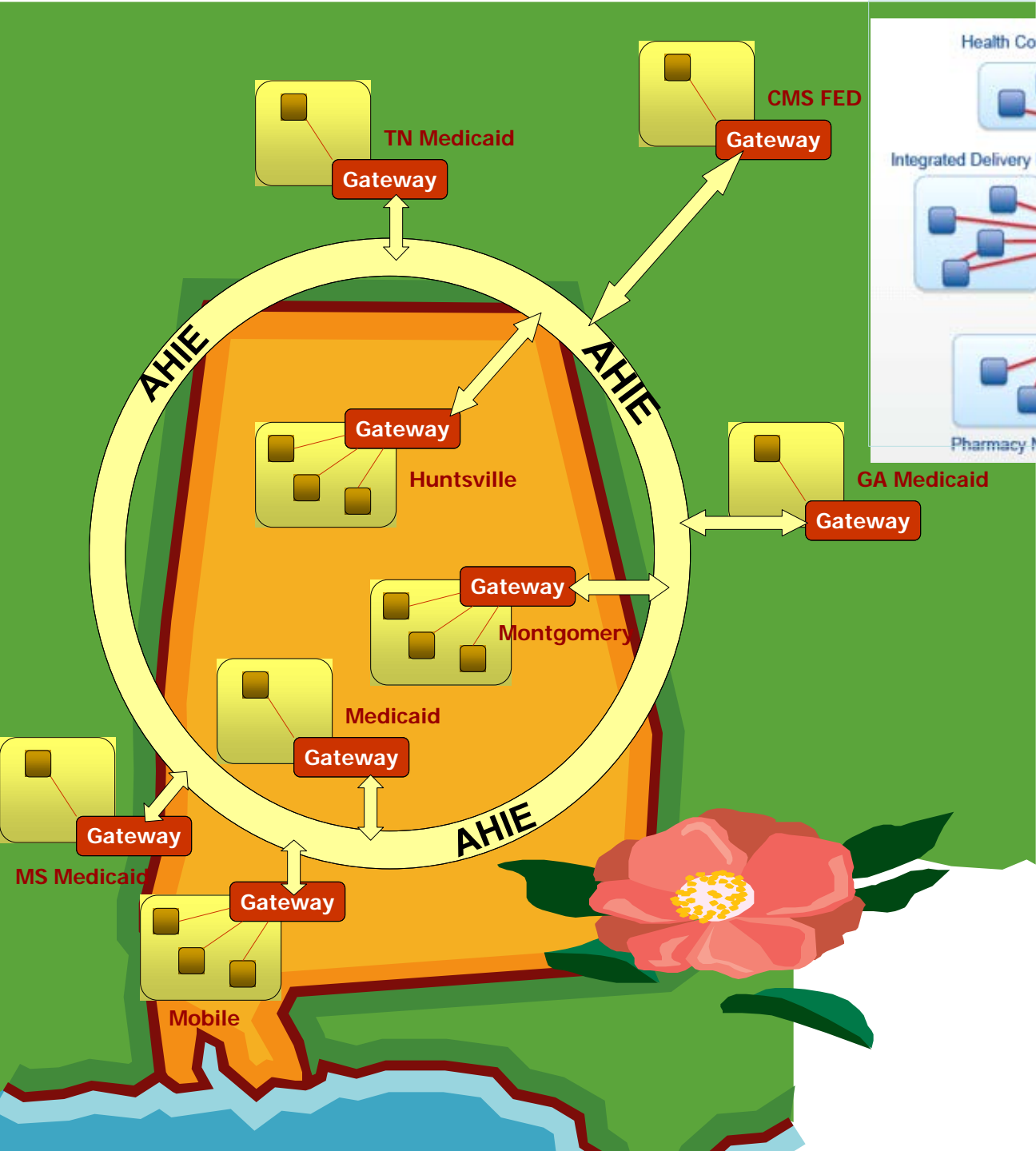
The HealthWay (eHealth Exchange)

- What is the *HealthWay*?

Nationwide Health Information Network.

It will provide a Federal secure, nationwide, interoperable health information infrastructure that will *connect* providers, consumers, and others involved in supporting health and healthcare. (Robust Query & Retrieval)

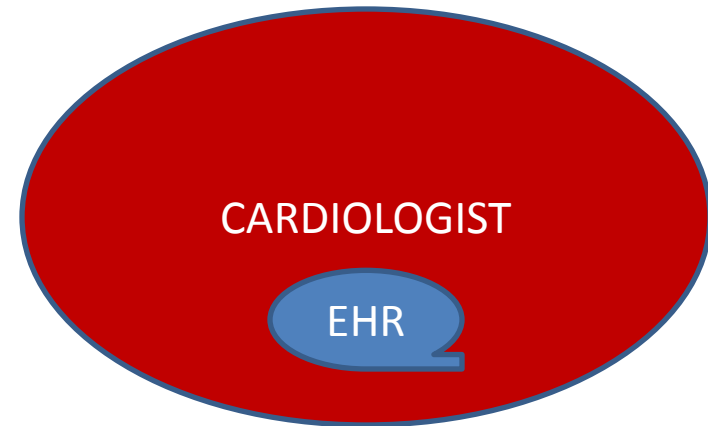
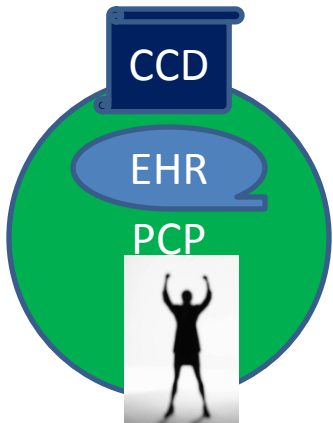
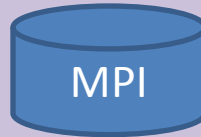
- Why is that important? One Health Record® is established on the same Federal standards and profiles (Integrated Health Exchange – IHE). Vendor agnostic – everybody through the same looking glass.

“Caveat Emptor” – EHR

- *“Trust”* in the Technology
 - Provider views their patients Info
 - Patients fear their PHI “floating” in clouds for all.
- Electronic Health Record Systems
 - Cost
 - Complexity
 - Complete (CCD Create/Update, Interoperable)
- Practice Management
 - Workflow changes
 - Loss of productivity (9 months?)

 - Qualified Services Organization Agreement (QSOA) (42 CFR part II for sensitive data).

- Once we receive the three signed document and a provider list, we will set up a Provider HIE Administration Web Account and schedule a HIE System Administrator Training session on how to use the HIE Web account and Direct secure messaging.
- After the training session, we can follow up and help you set up your clinician accounts and help send a DIRECT secure message.

A word or two about MU.....

How can One Health Record® help?

- NwHIN and HIPAA complaint, MU certified. MU2 upgrade in 2Q 2013.
 1. NwHIN – Federal Node Participant (Federal HIE a.k.a. e-health exchange)
 2. HIPAA – Privacy and Security Standards
 3. Meaningful Use certified – Using the HIE allows providers to meet various MU metrics.
- View, Download, Transmit
 1. HIE enabled Personal Health Record for on line access for patients. Provider initiated. (5% and 50% thresholds can be met.)
- Transitions of Care
 1. EHR approach – Publish CCD to the HIE (10% & 50% can be meet)
 2. Use Direct Secure messaging (PHI e-mail) for a point-to-point exchange. (Best example: No Fax)
- Public Health Reporting
 1. HIE Extracts data from the CDA/CCD HIE routes message to ADPH using required standards (HL7 2.5.1)
