- Effective August 8, 2013, John Heitman, ADPH IT Director, became Alabama's latest Health IT Coordinator. (My 4th)
- One Health Record MU 2 update: October 1, 2013.
- Alabama HIE Advisory Commission meeting planned for October 1, 2013.



One Health Record® - Today

- Core operations operational since April 2012 (18 Months)
- Current patient population: 1,000,000
- Production Node on eHealth Exchange (national network)
- Jackson and EAMC are live; UAB mid-September (9/23/2013).
- East Alabama Care Network (health home) connected (DSM)
- North Alabama CC Network moving with DSM)
- 5 CMHC's – 3 more in the Queue (DSM)
- 779 PHI exchange DSM's since March 2013, 245 Queries
- We are connected to Fla, SC, WV, Ga for DSM.
- State Agencies – Medicaid, ADMH, ADPH
- HIE Analytics – Utilization and Population Health.



One Health Record – Tomorrow

Expand the Footprint –Phase II



- Hospital Activity:
 - Brookwood MC & Huntsville & HCS connections possible by early 2014
 - Children’s Hosp. (Jan 2014) – DSM by October 2013
 - Infirmary Health – Connectivity Testing in October 2013
 - DW McMillian, Highlands, Eliza Coffee/Shoals Springhill MC in Fall 2013
 - Healthsouth – moving forward with DSM (Large footprint in Florida)
- Connectivity Grants to push HIE adoption among the private docs.
- RCO’s will be required to participate in One Health Record®
- ADPH Registries connected for reporting
- Tele-Medicine use will increase – Virtual Travel / Virtual Records
- Patient Portal and expansion of Provider Directory functionality
- Interstate HIE connections with Fla and Ga within 12 months.
- DSM connections with Miss, Michigan, and La by late Fall 2013; Online application with HIE document submission via the website.
- True HIE “Plug-and-Play” Standards for EHR systems being debated.
